Outdoor Watering Guidelines

On May 16, 2023, Beverly Hills City Council supported the continuation of maintaining previously adopted drought measures in support of continued water conservation in the region. Drought measures include:

- Two watering days a week during the summer months.
- No watering between 9am-6pm.
- Don't irrigate after measurable rainfall.
- Don't allow excessive water runoff due to sprinkler overspray or malfunctions.
- Repair leaks immediately.



Water Quality Report

The City is happy to announce that we, once again, provided high quality drinking water in the 2022 calendar year. The Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) is an annual water quality report that requires water suppliers to inform customers where their water comes from, what is in their water, and any violations of standards that may have occurred.

Indoor Water Saving Tips

- Wash only full loads of laundry and dishes and save up to 50 gallons per week.
- Fix household leaks promptly and save up to 20 gallons per day.
- Spend only 5 minutes in the shower and save up to 8 gallons each time
- Turn off the water while you brush your teeth and save up to 2.5 gallons per minute
- Buy water-saving devices like high-efficiency toilets and clothes washers and save many gallons per day



Clean Your Lateral Lines

Summer is a good time for property owners to clean their sewer laterals.

Lateral lines should be inspected and cleaned annually by a licensed plumber to avoid blockages and overflows. Cleaning involves using either a hydrojet or a snake to clear the line of any build up or tree roots that may have come into the line.

Tip: Notify the Public Works Department when you have scheduled your inspection so personnel can be present to collect and remove debris deposited into the City sewer system.



SOME TIPS WHEN SCHEDULING YOUR ANNUAL MAINTENANCE

- Get three different quotes.
- Ensure you use a licensed plumber or contractor with all the required permits.
- Request a video inspection for a view of the pipe before and after the work is done.
