4. Review of Draft Survey for Resident Interest in Traffic Calming Measures

Draft survey review to determine resident interest and direction for traffic calming measures in the Southwest area of the City.

Transportation Planner Jessie Holzer and Fehr & Peers Consultant Mike Samuelson presented three draft options for resident surveys to gauge resident interest and direction for the potential use of traffic calming measures in the Southwest area of the City. The Commission agreed that survey option 1 should be mailed to residents because it was the most streamlined, in order to encourage resident participation.

5. Update on New Legislation Regarding Electric Vehicle Charging Stations

Assistant Director of Public Works Chad Lynn and Parking Services Manager Genevieve Row presented a report on Senate Bill 1000 (SB-1000), which impacts policy on types of vehicles that may use electric vehicle charging stations. Currently, the City allows only battery-only electric vehicles to connect to City charging stations. The Commission supported moving forward with option 1, in which the City enacts a uniform policy in allowing hybrid and non-Battery Only Electric Vehicles (BOEVs)/Zero Emission Vehicles (ZEVs) to use electric vehicle charging stations.
